TWO COMPLEMENTARY AREAS

INTERDISCIPLINARY AREA

- EXPLORES consecrated life through theology, liturgy, history and the Magisterium.
- ADDRESSES Biblical hermeneutics, identity, significance and ecclesiality of consecrated life.
- PROVIDES tools to guide and accompany consecrated life in different socio-cultural contexts.

NORMATIVE AREA AND CANONICAL PRACTICE

- EXPLORE the specificity of the different forms of consecrated life, highlighting their common foundation.
- ADDRESSES current pressing issues in matters of discernment, formation, economic management, mission and fraternal life.
- PROVIDES a comprehensive vision of the law, starting from the Dicastery's practice, for those who perform specific services and for a critical reading of the norms currently in force.

DURATION

Two-year, cyclic course.

CLASSES

Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons.
From November to June.

EXAMS

February • June • October • December
